



Extra stability for
school chairs



Instruction

The MERU Rokzi system provides support and confidence to children sitting in ordinary plastic school chairs with tubular metal legs. Rokzi arms and legs simply clamp onto the metal chair legs, providing the advantage of armrests and anti-tip supports. These can also be combined with footrests and cushions to give children who may not otherwise sit well the confidence to use everyday school chairs.

Rokzi Arms

- Loosen both bolts from the clamp and place around the rear leg of the chair, positioning as shown.
- Adjust the armrest height by moving the pole through the clamp. Tighten both bolts to set.
- Ensure that the pole is flat against the chair to avoid finger traps.



Rokzi Legs

- Whilst on a level surface Loosen both bolts from the clamp and place around the rear leg of the chair.
- Position the leg so that it touches the floor, pointing out and away from the chair.
- Tighten both bolts to set.



Precautions

- Not suitable for children over 50kg.
- The Rokzi should only be used on the recommendation of a qualified health professional and installed by a competent person
- The Rokzi arms should not be exposed to naked flame or heat sources.
- Unsecured parts of the Rokzi system (the armrests, clamps, legs etc) should not be left around where children could pick them up.
- Children should be in a supervised environment while using A Rokzi.

Important: Rokzi Legz are only suitable for chairs with 19mm (3/4 inch) diameter legs. Do not attempt to fit to chair legs of any other size
